#### I. Call to Order

The Regular Board meeting of the Mississippi State Board of Examiners for Licensed Professional Counselors ("Board") was called to order at 11:06 a.m. by Dr. Richard Strebeck, Chair ("Chair") on Wednesday, June 26, 2019. The meeting was held via Teleconference and the public could attend the meeting in the Robert E. Lee Building, 239 North Lamar Street, Suite 402, Jackson, Mississippi 39201. A roll call of Board members was taken and a quorum was present. A determination vote for an Executive Session may be called at any time during the meeting.

#### **II. Board Operations**

#### A. Minutes Approval

It was motioned by Sallis, seconded by Etheridge, and unanimously agreed that

# D. <u>ProsonITech Invoice</u>

It was motioned by Etheridge, seconded by Strebeck, and unanimously agreed to pay the ProsonITech Invoice from the FY 2019 budget. 3-0

# E. AASCB Conference Registration Invoice

It was motioned by Sallis, seconded by Stafford, and unanimously agreed to pay registration fees to AASCB in the amount of \$600 (for two Board members' registration) and to deny payment of two additional fees for Board members to attend the AASCB meeting. Two Board members will attend the NBCC meeting and two Board members will attend the AASCB meeting. 3-0

#### **IV. Old Business**

#### A. OLRC-update regarding renewal compliance and CEH

Mr. Walley met with a representative from OLRC:

- P-LPC issued licenses are acceptable as issued concerning renewal date and fee
- 2. LPC licenses will be issued as currently issued

3. P-LPC CEU requirements remain as issued-6 CEH; however, law reads 12 CEH per year

# C. <u>LPC-S Requirements</u>

The Board discussed the change in required training hours to become an LPC-S. The previous training required 30 hours of professional training and the current requirement is 45 hours of professional training. The Board will accept the 30 hours of professional training from an LPC-S applicant if the professional training was completed by April 4, 2019. Any professional supervision training submitted to be counted toward LPC-S credential completed after April 4, 2019, must meet the 45-hour training requirement. The Board will request a list of LPCs who have completed the 30-hour supervision training from MLPCA.

#### **E.** Group Supervision Hours Clarification

Rule 4.3.B.1.e states "Group supervision will be acceptable for not more than fifty (50) hours of the required one hundred (100) hours of individual supervision. Two (2) hours of group supervision is equivalent to one (1) hour of individual supervision. Total hours of group supervision should be reported in full and will then be divided by two (2) by the Board at review time." Therefore, the maximum number of group supervision hours that will be counted toward licensure will be 50 which will equal 25 hours of individual supervision.

The Board completed the Attorney General Performance Survey. It was motioned by Etheridge, seconded by Sallis, and unanimously agreed to submit final results. 3-0

It was motioned by Stafford, seconded by Sallis, and unanimously agreed that the Board consider a motion to close the regular meeting to determine the necessity of an Executive Session. The Board determined that an Executive Session was needed to review BQS / P-LPC / LPC / Candidacy / Comity / Continued Review applications, and to discuss Board requests. 3-0

It was motioned by Strebeck, seconded by Stafford, and unanimously agreed that the Board exit the Regular session and enter Executive Session. 3-0 The Board entered Executive Session at 11:24 a.m.
